I. Introduction

- The Registry hereby submits the following observations pursuant to the Single Judge's instruction dated 21 December 2023, communicated by way of email ("Instruction").¹
- 2. The Instruction follow an *ex parte* communication sent by the Victims and Witnesses Unit ("VWU" or "Unit") to Trial Chamber V ("Chamber") on 15 December 2023,² seeking the Chamber's guidance ("Request for guidance").
- 3. In its Request for guidance, the VWU informed the Chamber that, within the scope of its activities related to the assessment of dual status witnesses [REDACTED].
- 4. [REDACTED] the Chamber instructed the VWU to share this information with the parties and participants, on the record, by 8 January 2024.
