PRE-TRIAL CHAMBER III (the 'Chamber') of the International Criminal Court (the 'Court') issues this notification of the election of the Presiding Judge.

- 1. On 12 March 2024, the Presidency of the Court recomposed the Chambers and assigned the situation of the Republic of Uganda and cases therein to this Chamber.¹
- 2. The Chamber notes regulation 13(2) of the Regulations of the Court, pursuant to which the Judges of each Pre-Trial Chamber 'shall elect from amongst their members a Presiding Judge who shall carry out the functions conferred upon him or her by the Statute, Rules or otherwise'.
- 3. On 13 March 2024, the Judges of the Chamber elected Judge Althea Violet Alexis-Windsor to act as the Presiding Judge of the Chamber with immediate effect.
