The Article 85 Chamber of the International Criminal Court (the ‘Chamber’), having regard to rule 174(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, issues the following ‘Order scheduling a hearing regarding Mr Mokom’s claim for compensation’ in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Maxime Jeoffroy Eli Mokom Gawaka*.

1. On 17 April 2024, Mr Mokom, through his counsel, filed a request for compensation pursuant to article 85 of the Statute (the ‘Request’) seeking, *inter alia*, a hearing on the Request.¹
2. On 10 May 2024, the Chamber issued the ‘Decision on Mr Mokom’s request for leave to reply and request for a hearing’, in which it gave notice that a hearing on the Request would take place on 21 August 2024.²
3. On 2 July 2024, the Chamber emailed Counsel for Mr Mokom, the Prosecution, and the Registry to advise that due to a scheduling conflict, the hearing was rescheduled to 9 September 2024.³
4. The hearing is therefore scheduled for 9 September 2024, from 10:00 to 11:30 and from 14:00 to 15:30.
5. Given that part of Mr Mokom’s complaint concerns the actions of the Registry following his release by Pre-Trial Chamber II, a representative from the Registry is required to participate in the hearing.
6. Counsel for Mr Mokom will be given 60 minutes and the Prosecution will be given 30 minutes to address each other’s submissions and provide any final observations. The Registry, should it choose to make submissions, will also be given 30 minutes. The parties and the Registry may also be requested to address potential questions from the Chamber.

FOR THESE REASONS, THE CHAMBER HEREBY

SCHEDULES a hearing to take place on 9 September 2024, from 10:00 to 11:30 and from 14:00 to 15:30, for a maximum duration of three hours.
