² The Prosecution's case in chief consisted of 85 witnesses, of which 58 witnesses' direct examinations were completed in 117 hours 40 minutes of the 122 hours allotted (see ICC-01/14-01/21-479, para. 5). Furthermore, 25 witnesses testified *viva voce* and 33 witnesses testified under rule 68(3) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("Rules"). Additionally 16 witnesses were certified and admitted under rule 68(2)(b) of the Rules, and seven witnesses were admitted under rule 68(2)(c) whereas four witnesses were not called to testify.
