I. INTRODUCTION

1. The Registry hereby transmits to the Appeals Chamber (“Chamber”) a document entitled “*Additional Clarifications on Document Submission and Procedural Concerns Related to Recusal Request and Ethical Review*”, and “*Clarification of Legal Reference in Arcadia Foundation’s Submission on the Request for the Recusal of Prosecutor Karim A. II. PROCEDURAL HISTORY


