I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby submits as annex to this filing, the supporting material presented by the Comon Legal Representatives of Victims (“CLRV”) during the Reparations Hearing dated 8 September 2026.

II. Procedural History

2. On 2 April 2026, Trial Chamber I issued a decision scheduling a reparations hearing to be held on 8 September 2026 (“reparations hearing”).¹
3. On 8 September 2026, the CLRV referred to a presentation in support of their submissions (“presentation”).²
4. In compliance with regulation 29 of the Regulations of the Registry (“RoR”), a Hearing not Evidence (“HNE”) reference was assigned to the presentation. Upon the Registry’s request,³ the CLRV confirmed its classification level.

II. Classification

5. Pursuant to regulation 23*bis*(1) of the Regulations of the Court, the annex to the present filing is classified as “confidential” as it refers to sensitive information that should not be disclosed to the public.

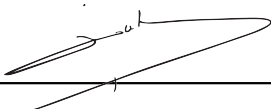
III. Applicable law
