I. Introduction

1. The Registry submits with the present report and its 29 annexes, the public and confidential versions of email decisions pursuant to the “Directions on the conduct of proceedings” (“Directions”),¹ issued on 19 June 2026 by Trial Chamber III (“Chamber”), from 1 May to 31 August 2026.

II. Procedural History

2. On 19 June 2026, the Chamber issued the Directions instructing the Registry “to file all email decisions on the case record in quarterly reports”, which also should comprise the decisions issued up to the publication date of the Directions.²
3. The Chamber further directed the Registry to simultaneously file public and confidential versions of email decisions.³
4. The parties and participants were instructed to: i) include as recipients all persons identified as such by the parties, the Registry, or any relevant participant, unless excluded for confidentiality reasons; ii) use a clear title in the email subject line which shall begin with the case record number ICC-01/21-01/25, and the level of classification of the email communication; iii) frame email submissions in a way that makes their publication possible; and iv) omit any names and contact details of Chambers staff.⁴

III. Level of classification

5. Pursuant to regulation 23*bis* (1) of the Regulations of the Court, some of the annexes are classified as “confidential” and “confidential *ex parte*” as they refer to sensitive information that should not be disclosed to the public.

IV. Applicable law

6. For the purpose of the present submission, the Registry considered articles 64(7), 64(10) and 67(1) of the Rome Statute and rule 137 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

V. Submissions

7. In the Directions, the Chamber provided criteria for the application of the redactions to the email decisions. The Registry was instructed *inter alia* to apply redactions to: i) names of Chambers staff members, where applicable; ii) names of Registry staff members, if deemed necessary by the Registry; and iii) any email address or other private or personal information.⁵ The Registry shall consult the parties and participants on the redactions applied.⁶
8. Accordingly, following consultations with the parties and participants, the Registry applied redactions to emails set forth in the following annexes:
