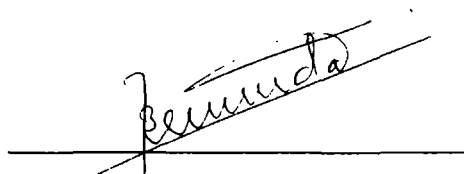

Background

1. On 14 December 2007, the Prosecution filed the "Submission of the Prosecution's Summary of Presentation of Evidence".¹ The lists of the Prosecution's evidence were annexed to the filings.²

Correction

2. On 18 December 2007, the Prosecution noted several inaccuracies in the Annexes to both filings referred to in paragraph 1, including the fact that a number of documents that had been disclosed as incriminatory were omitted from the list of such documents in the Annexes.³
