- On 13 October 2006, the Appeals Chamber delivered its Judgment on the Prosecutor's appeal against the decision of Pre-Trial Chamber I entitled "Decision Establishing General Principles Governing Applications to Restrict Disclosure pursuant to Rule 81 (2) and (4) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence" 1
- 2. The Appeals Chamber determined that whenever a submission is filed *ex parte* and an application for *ex parte* proceedings is filed, the other participant must in principle be made aware in an *inter partes* filing of the fact that such an application was filed as well as of its legal basis.<sup>2</sup>
- 3. In compliance with this ruling, the Office of the Prosecutor (hereinafter referred to as "Prosecution") respectfully submits to the Defence this Notification in regards to the following Prosecutor's position which was filed *ex parte*.
- 4. On 23 July 2008 the PTC III issued the "Decision concerning the Prosecutor's proposals for redactions"<sup>3</sup> which was received by the Prosecution on 24 July 2008.
- 5. On 4 September 2008 the Prosecution filed the "Prosecutor's Position regarding Pre-Trial Chamber III's Order Requiring the Prosecution to Disclose the Identity of the Witnesses not Previously Mentioned on Whom the Prosecution Intends to Rely at the Confirmation Hearing by 4 September 2008"
- 6. For the reasons set forth above, the Prosecution notifies the Defence of the following *ex parte* filing:
