

1. The trial in the case of *Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo* is presently scheduled to commence on 5 July 2010.
2. Due to administrative reasons, in particular the likely change in the composition of the Bench, and to facilitate necessary preparation for the commencement of the trial, pursuant to Article 64(3)(a) of the Rome Statute, and Rule 132 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the trial date of 5 July 2010 is vacated.
3. The trial will commence on 14 July 2010 at 14.30, when counsel will deliver their opening speeches. On 15 July 2010 the Chamber will hear any outstanding speeches and address any necessary trial and case-management issues.
4. Given the fixed judicial recess extends from 17 July until 9 August 2010, and in order to ensure effective witness scheduling and trial preparation, the evidence in the case will commence on Monday 30 August 2010.
