NOTING the “Decision informing the United Nations Security Council about the Lack of Cooperation by the Republic of Sudan” (“the Decision”), issued by the Chamber on 25 May 2010;²

NOTING the “Report of the Registrar on the notification of the “Decision informing the United Nations Security Council about the Lack of Cooperation by the Republic of Sudan”, filed on 8 July 2010, and the annexes attached thereto, whereby the Registrar (i) informed the Chamber that the Decision had been transmitted to the Secretary-General of the United Nations in all the languages of the United Nations and (ii) requested guidance from the Chamber on the appropriateness of informing the Sudanese authorities about the Decision and its transmission to the United Nations;

CONSIDERING appropriate that both the Decision and the documents contained in Annex 1 attached to the Registry’s Report in relation to the transmission of the Decision to the United Nations be notified to the Sudanese authorities;

FOR THESE REASONS,

INSTRUCT


The Registrar to transmit to the authorities of the State of Sudan: (i) the “Decision informing the United Nations Security Council about the Lack of Cooperation by the Republic of Sudan”; and (ii) the Note Verbale transmitting
