**NOTING** the "Decision setting a time-limit for the submission of new victims' applications for participation" issued by Trial Chamber III (the "Chamber");<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** article 68(3) of the Statute, rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 86(5) of the Regulations of the Court;

**CONSIDERING** that approximately 1000 applications are being processed by the Registry 10% of which will have to be completed at a later stage;

**CONSIDERING** that therefore an approximate number of 850 to 900 applications for participation in the proceedings will be submitted;

**CONSIDERING** that of these, 218 applications to participate in the proceedings have already been transmitted to the Chamber;<sup>2</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that 176 further applications have now been processed and redacted in accordance with the guidelines established by the Chamber;

**CONSIDERING** that the Registry will transmit these 176 applications in redacted form to the parties and the legal representatives of the applicants in accordance with the Chamber's instructions;

**CONSIDERING** that the Registry will also prepare and transmit to the Chamber an individual report for each of the applications annexed to this report;
