I, Judge Sanji Mmasenono Monageng, the Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber I of the

International Criminal Court ("Chamber" and "Court" respectively) responsible for

carrying out the functions of the Chamber in relation to the case of *The Prosecutor v. Callixte* 

Mbarushimana;1

NOTING that, at the hearing of the first appearance of Mr Callixte Mbarushimana, held

on 28 January 2011, the Chamber scheduled the commencement of the confirmation of the

charges hearing for 4 July 2011;

NOTING article 68(3) of the Rome Statute, rule 89 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence,

regulations 33 and 86 of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that the Single Judge finds it appropriate to set a deadline for the

transmission of any applications for participation as victims in the pre-trial stage of the

proceedings in the present case, including the confirmation of the charges hearing;

**CONSIDERING** that applications for participation that are incomplete at the date set in

the present decision will not be examined by the Single Judge;

FOR THESE REASONS,

ORDER the Victims Participation and Reparation Section to transmit to the Chamber

complete applications for participation as victims in the proceedings at the pre-trial stage

of the case, including in the confirmation of the charges hearing, as soon as practicable and

no later than 45 days before the day of the commencement of the confirmation of charges

hearing.
