NOTING article 68(3) of the Rome Statute, rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 86(4) of the Regulations of the Court;

NOTING the oral decision of Trial Chamber I (the “Chamber”) of 11 May 2011,¹ ordering the Registry to transmit “to the Chamber without redactions and to the parties with any redactions that are necessary”,² the “supplementary information received by the Victims Participation and Reparations Section as regards seven applications”;³

NOTING that the Registry transmitted applications a/1610/10 and a/1619/10 to the Chamber on 3 March 2011,⁴ and to the parties in a redacted form on 14 March 2011;⁵

CONSIDERING that the Victims Participation and Reparations Section has received supplementary information in relation to applications a/1610/10 and a/1619/10 on 24 March 2011;

CONSIDERING that the supplementary information relating to applications a/1610/10 and a/1619/10 contains information which may lead to the identification of the applicants and their whereabouts;

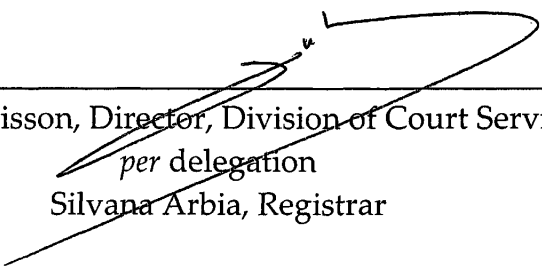
