Introduction

1. The Defence of Mohammed Hussein Ali joins the Defence teams of Francis Kirimi Muthaura and Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta in requesting for disclosure of the Unredacted Article 58 Application and all Statements, Declarations, Testimonies and Utterances in the Possession of the Prosecution in so far as they apply to Mohammed Hussein Ali.

Procedural history

- 2. On 15 December 2010, the Office of the Prosecutor (the "OTP") submitted the "Prosecutor's Application Pursuant to Article 58 as to Ambassador Francis Kirimi Muthaura, Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta and Mohammed Hussein Ali" (the "Article 58 Application").¹
- 3. On 8 March 2011, Pre-Trial Chamber II (the "PTC"), by majority issued three summonses to appear in the present case.²
- 4. On 6 April 2011, the Single Judge issued the "Decision Setting the Regime for Evidence Disclosure and Other Related Matters" establishing, *inter alia*, the system of disclosure to be followed by the parties in this case.³
- 5. On 23 June 2011, counsel for Ambassador Francis Kirimi Muthaura filed "Defence Request for Disclosure of Unredacted Article 58 Application and All Statements, Declarations, Testimonies And Utterances Of Ambassador Francis K. Muthaura in the Possession of the Prosecution" ("Muthaura's Request")⁴

On 29 June 2011, counsel for Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta filed "Application on Behalf of Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta to Join the Defence Request for Disclosure of the Unredacted Article 58 Application and all Statements, Declarations, Testimonies and Utterances of Uhuru Muigai Kenyatta in the Possession of the Prosecution" ("Kenyatta's Request")⁵

Submissions

7. The Defence for General Mohammed Hussein Ali files this application to join paragraphs 10, 11, and 13 to 19 inclusive of Muthaura's Request as applicable to General Ali.

Conclusion

8. The Defence respectfully requests that the Single Judge order the Prosecution to disclose to the Defence its Article 58 Application in unreducted or lesser reducted form and all statements, declarations, testimonies and utterances of Mohammed Hussein Ali in the possession and control of the Prosecution without delay.
