### **INTRODUCTION**

- 1. On 20 April 2011, the Single Judge set the regime for disclosure in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Muthaura et al.* In accordance with rule 121(4) of the Rules of Evidence and Procedure, the Single Judge ordered that the Defence disclose any evidence in which it intends to rely upon for the purposes of the Confirmation of Charges hearing (the "Hearing") no later than fifteen days before the Hearing.<sup>1</sup>
- 2. In compliance with this order, the Defence Team for Major General Mohammed Hussein Ali hereby submits its List of Evidence in which it intends to rely upon at the Hearing and its detailed Analysis Chart. The Defence requests that the attached Annexes A and B be received by the Single Judge as "Confidential" as they contain information of a sensitive nature not currently available to the public and/or were obtained from persons requesting confidentiality from the public.
