NOTING Trial Chamber IV’s “Order inviting the Registrar to appoint a common legal representative” dated 7 September 2011 (the “Decision”),¹ inviting the Registry to proceed in accordance with Rule 90(3) of the Rules;

NOTING article 68(3) of the Rome Statute; rules 16(1)(b) and 90(2) to 90(5) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulation 81(4) of the Regulations of the Court; regulations 109(2) and 109(3) of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 15(2) 16 and 18 of the Code of Professional Conduct for Counsel;

CONSIDERING that in its “Proposal on common legal representation”,² the Registry recommended that it was not aware of any reason why all the victims participating in the case could not be represented by a single team of common legal representatives and that the victims in this case would benefit from the establishment of a common legal representation team comprising a counsel and an associate counsel;

CONSIDERING that the Registry conducted an open and transparent selection of legal representatives to implement its responsibilities in relation to common legal representation, which included consideration of both the current legal representatives of victims, as well as other interested and qualified counsel, in a transparent and objective manner according to identified selection criteria;

CONSIDERING that annexes 1 and 2 to the present document are classified as confidential because they contain contact information of the legal representatives;


For these reasons,
