The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (The “Court”);

NOTING the oral decision of Trial Chamber III (the “Chamber”)¹ of 2 December 2010 ordering the Registry to send to the Chamber a newly redacted version with the minimum necessary redaction of the application for participation of a victim who also appeared as a witness;

NOTING the Chamber’s “Decision on 270 applications by victims to participate in the proceedings”² dated 25 October 2011 ordering the Registry to provide the parties with a lesser redacted version of application a/0407/11 completed by an individual who also appeared as a witness before the Chamber;

NOTING article 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute and rule 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence;

CONSIDERING that application a/0407/11 was transmitted to the Chamber³ in a non-redacted form and to the parties⁴ in a redacted form on 15 July 2011;

CONSIDERING that victim a/0407/11 was granted participating status by the Chamber and has also appeared as a witness before the Court;⁵

CONSIDERING that on 30 October 2011 the Chamber provided the Registry with a hard copy of the application of the said victim highlighting the redactions to be lifted and that the Registry has prepared a newly redacted version of the application in accordance with the Chamber’s instructions;


