**The Registrar of the International Criminal Court ("the Court"):**

**NOTING** the "Public Redacted Version of the Decision Requesting Libya to file Observations Regarding the Arrest of Saif Al-Islam Gaddafi" dated 6 December 2011;<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** the "Report of the Registrar on Libya's observations regarding the arrest of Saif Al-Islam Gaddafi"<sup>2</sup> dated 23 January 2012;

**NOTING** the "Decision on the Registry-OPCD Visit to Libya"<sup>3</sup> dated 3 February 2012;

**NOTING** the "Decision on Libya's Submissions Regarding the Arrest of Saif Al-Islam Gaddafi"<sup>4</sup> dated 7 March 2012 ("the Decision")

**NOTING** Rule 176 (2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and Regulation 23 *bis* of the Regulations of the Court;

**CONSIDERING** that Pre-Trial Chamber I ("the Chamber") requested the Libyan authorities (1) "to make its decision to grant the Surrender Request and to inform the Chamber accordingly within seven days of notification of the Arabic translation of the present decision", (2) "to arrange with the Registry for Saif Al-Islam Gaddafi's surrender to the Court", and requested the Registry to "inform the Chamber as to the arrangements regarding the surrender of Saif Al-Islam Gaddafi to the Court within


fourteen days of notification to the Libyan authorities of the Arabic translation of the present decision"<sup>5</sup>;

**INFORMS** the Chamber as follows:

1. The Registry transmitted by e-mail the Decision and its Arabic translation to the Libyan authorities through its designated channel of communication on 13 March 2012;
2. The Libyan Authorities acknowledged the receipt on 15 March 2012;
3. On 21 March the Registry received a letter for the Libyan authorities informing the Registrar of the appointment of three counsels to represent Libya in the proceedings and requesting the Registry to transmit a filing to the Chamber. The filing was not signed.
4. On 22 March, the Registry requested the counsels to submit a signed version of the filing directly to the Court management section.

- The memorandum of notification acknowledging receipt by the Libyan authorities (Annex 2);
- The Letter from the Libyan National Coordinator to the ICC dated 19 March 2012 (Annex 3).
