Section

- 1. In the "Decision on the schedule leading up to trial" issued on 9 July 2012, Trial Chamber V ("the Chamber") instructed the Prosecution and the Defence teams ("the Parties") "to liaise with a view to reaching agreement about non-contentious issues", and file a first joint submission on agreed facts by 3 September 2012.¹ On 3 September 2012, the Parties filed a Regulation 35 of the Regulations of the Court motion for extension of this deadline until 5 September 2012.² On the same day, the Chamber granted the motion.³
- 2. The discussions between the Parties have resulted in mutual agreements on certain facts that are listed in Annex A to this submission. The parties are continuing to confer in order to potentially agree on more facts that are currently in dispute. As soon as any agreements are reached, they will be communicated to the Chamber at the earliest opportunity.
