The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”);

NOTING the Disciplinary Board Decision dated 18 June 2012 (the “Board’s Decision”) suspending Mr. Joseph Keta for a period of three months;¹

NOTING article 68 of the Rome Statute, rules 16 and 90 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, articles 15, 17, 41-3 and 42-1-d of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel, articles 13-1 and 17-2 of the Rules and Procedures of the Disciplinary Board and the Disciplinary Appeals Board;

CONSIDERING that the period of the suspension of Mr. Joseph Keta ended on 24 September 2012 and that accordingly the latter may resume his practice before the Court on this date;²

CONSIDERING that prior to his suspension Mr. Joseph Keta represented 63 victims in the Situation (the “Concerned Victims”);³

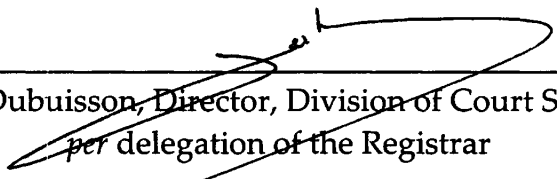
NOTIFIES the Chamber, parties and participants that Mr. Joseph Keta resumes his practice before the Court from 24 September 2012;
