NOTING Pre-Trial Chamber II’s Decision notified on 11 November 2010, ordering the Victims Participation and Reparations Section (the “VPRS”) to report periodically every three months on the applications received in the situation in the Central African Republic and the progress made by the VPRS on their assessment under rule 85 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (the “Decision”);¹

NOTING the Registry’s eighth periodic report on applications received in the situation in the Central African Republic (the “Situation”), notified on 9 November 2012 (the “Last 2012 Report”);²

NOTING articles 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rules 16(1) and 89(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 86 of the Regulations of the Court;

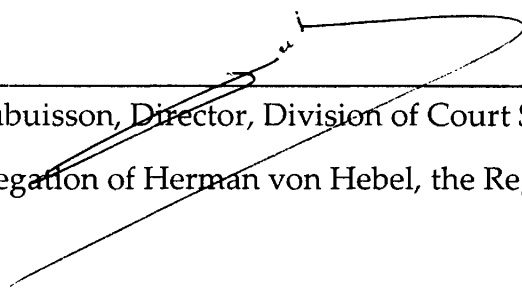
CONSIDERING that at the current stage no judicial proceeding in which the Chamber has determined that victims may participate have been initiated relating to the Situation;
