1. The Prosecution recently notified the Chamber of the possibility of travel yesterday by President Omar Al Bashir to the Democratic Republic of the Congo to attend the Common Market for Eastern and Southern Africa (COMESA) summit in Kinshasa due to be held on 26-27 February 2014.¹
