Introduction

1. The Prosecution herewith submits its communication of the disclosure of material falling within Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.

Procedural background

2. On 4 April 2014, the Prosecution filed its "Prosecution's Fifth Report on the Status of Disclosure of Documents Obtained under Article 54(3)(e)",¹ informing the Single Judge that it expected a response concerning the lifting of restrictions for a significant number of documents. On 7 April 2014, the Prosecution received this response, confirming the lifting of restrictions to 184 documents.

Disclosure of evidence

3. On 16 April 2014, the Prosecution disclosed these 184 items, as well as one additional item, to the Defence, for a total of 185 disclosed items. The Prosecution appends the list of the evidence disclosed in Confidential Annex A.
