THE REGISTRY of the International Criminal Court (the "Court"):

NOTING Resolution 1593 (2005) of the United Nations Security Council, referring the situation in Darfur to the Court¹;

NOTING the warrants of arrest against Omar Al-Bashir dated 4 March 2009 and 12 July 2010²;

NOTING the Registry's "Request for Arrest and Surrender for Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir" dated 18 November 2013;

NOTING the "Report of the Registry on the 'Decision Regarding Omar Al-Bashir's Potential Travel to the State of Kuwait' "4 dated 4 December 2013;

NOTING the "Prosecution's urgent notification of travel in the case of *The Prosecutor v Omar Al Bashir*" dated 24 March 2014;

NOTING the "Decision Regarding Omar Al-Bashir's Potential Travel to the State of Kuwait" ("the Decision") issued by Pre-Trial Chamber II ("the Chamber") on 24 March 2014;

NOTING the "Report of the Registry on the 'Decision Regarding Omar Al-Bashir's Potential Travel to the State of Kuwait' "7 ("the first Registry report"), dated 11 April 2014;

NOTING articles 87(l)((5) and 89(1) of the Rome Statute, rule 176(2) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulation 23(*bis*) of the Regulations of the Court;

CONSIDERING that the Chamber ordered the Registrar *inter alia* "to remind the State of Kuwait of the request for the arrest and surrender and the two warrants of arrest as already transmitted to the competent authorities of that country on 18 November 2013"⁸, and "to send a Note Verbale to the State of Kuwait, enquiring about Omar Hassan Ahmad Al-Bashir's visit"⁹;

CONSIDERING that the Chamber ordered the Registrar "to prepare a report to be filed with the Chamber in due course concerning said visit" ¹⁰;

CONSIDERING that in its First report the Registry informed the Chamber that no reply was received from the authorities of Kuwait to the date of the filing¹¹;

INFORMS the Chamber as follows:

- 1. On 23 April 2013 the Registry received observations from the Embassy of the State of Kuwait regarding Omar Al-Bashir's visit to Kuwait. (Annex 1).
- 2. According to the news reports Omar Al-Bashir attended the Arab League Summit in Kuwait city on 25 and 26 March 2014 (Annex 2).
