1. <u>Introduction</u>

1. On 11 December 2014, Pre-Trial Chamber 1 rendered it's Decision on the Côte d'Ivoire's challenge to the admissibility of the case against Ms. Simone Gbagbo.¹

2. On 17 December 2014, the Republic of Côte d'Ivoire filed an Appeal pursuant to Article 82, paragraph 1, (a) of the Statute of Rome against the aforesaid Decision² and included a request for suspensive effect pursuant to Article 82, paragraph 3 of the Statute of Rome and a request for an extension of time in which to file a supporting document.³

3. On 23 December 2014, the Appeals Chamber rendered it's 'Decision on the Côte d'Ivoire's request for time extension' granting until the 9 January 2015 'to file document in support of the appeal'.⁴

4. On 9 January 2015, the Côte d'Ivoire filed document in support of appeal.

5. Regulation 64 (4) of the Court permits a participant to file a Response to the said document within 21 days of notification of the document in support. The estimated due date for filing such a Response is 2nd February 2015.

2. Background to Request for time extension

6. Lead Counsel is aware that Simone Gbagbo is desirous of exercising her right to make a

Response. For the purpose of taking instructions and pursuant to the Registrars permission,

Lead Counsel travelled to Côte d'Ivoire on 17th January 2015, where Mme Gbagbo is

detained.

7. Certain difficulties have now arisen whereby, as of the time of writing, no permission to

visit Mme. Gbagbo has been granted by the relevant local authorities. Neither is it known

when or if such permission will be granted. However, after travelling this distance and ever

mindful of judicial economy, Lead Counsel submits it would be most wise to allow some

time for a decision on the permission to be made by the relevant authorities and for the

permission to ensue in due course.

8. Further, when access is granted, it is expected that Mme. Gbagbo may be somewhat

debilitated from the cumulative hardship of almost four years in detention and the stress of

the ongoing local trial. This of itself, may further slow matters.

9. In addition to those foreseeable but unexpected delays and allowing for an estimated two

days of travel time to home, Lead Counsel submits that there will be insufficient time to take

instructions in Côte d'Ivoire, collate the aforesaid instructions, carry out research, formulate

and draft the Response and file the document by 2nd February 2015.

3. Relief Requested

10. Pursuant to regulation 35 (2) of the Regulations of the Court which provides that the

Chamber may extend a time limit if good cause is shown, Counsel hereby applies for an

extension of time by four days, in which to submit a Response to the document in support of

appeal of Côte d'Ivoire. That is to say, to Friday 6th February 2015 or as the Chamber may

otherwise deem appropriate. May it please the Court.
