Prosecution's Report

1. In the "Decision Setting the Regime for Evidence Disclosure and Other Related Matters",¹ the then Single Judge ordered the Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") to submit a monthly progress report on the status of documents affected by article 54(3)(e) of the Rome Statute. The Prosecution hereby submits its second report.
2. On 31 March 2015, the Prosecution filed its first report on the status of disclosure of documents obtained under article 54(3)(e) as ordered.²
3. The status of disclosure remains unchanged since the Prosecution's first report. To date, article 54(3)(e) restrictions have been lifted on 5,899 documents, amounting to 46,176 pages. The Prosecution continues to consult with information providers and seek their consent to lift restrictions from 320 documents, amounting to 797 pages, that remain subject to article 54(3)(e) restrictions.
