
**The Registrar of the International Criminal Court ("the Court"),**

**NOTING** the Defence's challenge of the jurisdiction of the Court notified on 25 May 2012 (the "Challenge to Jurisdiction");<sup>1</sup>

**NOTING** the Chamber's Decision notified on 15 June 2012, whereby, the Office of Public Counsel for Victims is appointed, for the purposes of the proceedings following the Challenge to jurisdiction, to represent those victims who have submitted applications to participate in the proceedings in the present case and whose applications have not yet been assessed by the Chamber (the "15 June Decision");<sup>2</sup>

**CONSIDERING** that the Registry has received to date a total of 190 applications to participate in the proceedings in the present case;

**NOTIFIES** the parties and participants that the OPCV represents the 190 victims and applicants listed in annex 1 for the purpose of the proceedings following the Challenge to Jurisdiction, in accordance with the 15 June Decision.
