1. On 9 March 2012, the Prosecution filed its second request for redactions pursuant to Rule 81(2) and Rule 81(4) ("Second Redaction Request").¹ Attached to the Second Redaction Request were eight annexes. Annex 1 includes an additional transcript of a witness for whom redactions were sought previously² and Annexes 2 to 5 relate to four witnesses interviewed by the Prosecution between 25 October 2011 and 15 February 2012.³ Annexes 6 to 8 relate to open source documents, United Nations documents (maps) and a document from national judicial authorities. Each annex includes a table that identifies the exact redactions requested to the text of the documents as well as to its metadata and provides the factual basis for each individual redaction. In addition, each annex includes copies of the relevant documents with highlighted text for which redactions are requested.
2. During the *ex parte* status conference held on 20 March 2012, the Single Judge pointed out that [REDACTED]⁴ [REDACTED].⁵
3. As discussed during the status conference referred to above, [REDACTED].⁶ It therefore is separately submitting a corrigendum to its First Redaction Request [REDACTED].
4. [REDACTED]. In order to maintain consistency among the two redaction requests, the Prosecution hereby presents a corrigendum to the Second Redaction Request [REDACTED].
5. In particular, this corrigendum concerns Annexes 3 and 5 of the Second Redaction Request [REDACTED].
6. The Prosecution also noted at the hearing that it erroneously omitted to request redactions pursuant to Rule 81(2) in a limited number of instances in which the

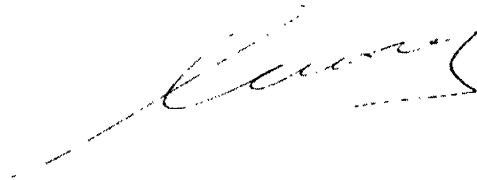

documents referred to the identity of its investigators. The Prosecution hereby clarifies that its Second Redaction Request was intended to extend to all instances where reference to the identity of its investigators is made.

7. Pursuant to Regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court, the Prosecution files both this cover filing and its annexes confidential, *ex parte*, only available to the Prosecution. The cover filing refers to the discussion held *ex parte* during the status conference, while knowledge by the Defence of the content of the annexes would defeat their purpose. In accordance with the Disclosure Decision, the Prosecution will present a public redacted version of this filing (without the annexes), to put the Defence on notice of the existence of this corrigendum.
