Pre-Trial Chamber I

THE PRESIDENCY of the International Criminal Court (“Court”);

NOTING the decision of the Pre-Trial Chamber I dated 11 December 2014 which, *inter alia*, confirmed, pursuant to article 61(7) of the Rome Statute of the International Criminal Court (“Statute”), the charges presented by the Prosecutor against Charles Blé Goudé to the extent specified in paragraphs 182-194 of that decision, and committed Charles Blé Goudé to a Trial Chamber for trial on the charges as confirmed (“Decision Confirming the Charges”);¹

CONSIDERING article 61(11) of the Statute, pursuant to which the Presidency shall constitute a Trial Chamber once the charges have been confirmed, which shall be responsible for the conduct of subsequent proceedings;

CONSIDERING rule 130 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence (“Rules”), pursuant to which the Presidency shall refer the case to a Trial Chamber and transmit to it the decision confirming the charges and the records of the proceedings of the Pre-Trial Chamber;

CONSIDERING the email of the Senior Legal Adviser of the Pre-Trial Division to the Registry dated 17 December 2014, in which the Senior Legal Adviser, on behalf of Pre-Trial Chamber I, requested the Registry “de transmettre . . . à La Présidence, en application de la règle 129 du Règlement de procédure et de preuve, la décision de confirmation des charges ainsi que le dossier de la procédure devant la Chambre préliminaire dans l’affaire Charles Blé Goudé”;

CONSIDERING that the record of the proceedings before Pre-Trial Chamber I and the decision confirming the charges were transmitted, by the Registrar, to the Presidency on 18 December 2014, in accordance with rule 129 of the Rules;²

HEREBY REFERS the case of The Prosecutor v. Charles Blé Goudé to Trial Chamber I;
and
