1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") notifies Pre-Trial Chamber I ("Chamber") of its disclosure, on 10 September 2014, of two incriminating items.¹
2. Pursuant to the Prosecution's notice dated 27 August 2014,² the Prosecution re-disclosed CIV-OTP-0001-0399 and CIV-OTP-0002-0141 as incriminating evidence. These items were previously disclosed pursuant to Rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and are currently on the List of Evidence for the confirmation of charges.³ The disclosed material was provided in a format that complies with the eCourt protocol approved by the Chamber.
