

NOTING article 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23*bis*, 67, 69 and 73 of the Regulations of the Court (the "Regulations"), regulation 123 of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel¹ (the "Code");

RESPECTFULLY INFORMS the Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber I that Mr. Mohamed Aouini was appointed as duty counsel to represent Mr Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi ("Mr Al Faqi") before the Court by letter dated 22 September 2015.² His mandate as duty counsel was further extended until the end of the initial appearance of Mr Al Faqi before the Chamber.³ Mr Aouini executed the solemn undertakings required by articles 5 and 22(3) of the Code on 24 August 2015,⁴ which remain valid for the purpose of these proceedings.

SUBMITS the present document and its Annex III as public, whereas Annexes I and II hereto are classified as confidential, in accordance with regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations, as they contain private contact details of Mr Aouini.
