NOTING article 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 21 and 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulations 23bis, 67, 69 and 73 of the Regulations of the Court (the "Regulations"), regulation 123 of the Regulations of the Registry, and articles 5, 8 and 22(3) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (the "Code");

RESPECTFULLY INFORMS the Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber I that Mr. Mohamed Aouini was appointed as duty counsel to represent Mr Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi ("Mr Al Faqi") before the Court by letter dated 22 September 2015.² His mandate as duty counsel was further extended until the end of the initial appearance of Mr Al Faqi before the Chamber.³ Mr Aouini executed the solemn undertakings, required by articles 5 and 22(3) of the Code on 24 August 2015, ⁴ which remain valid for the purpose of these proceedings.
