The Registrar of the International Criminal Court (the “Court”);

NOTING Trial Chamber VI’s (the “Chamber”) Decision on victims’ participation in trial proceedings notified on 6 February 2015, directing the Victims Participation and Reparations Section (the “VPRS”) to file every four months, in cooperation with the Legal Representatives of Victims (“LRVs”), a detailed report about the victims admitted to participate in the proceedings and the general situation of participating victims (the “First Victim Participation Decision”);¹

NOTING the Chamber’s Fourth decision on victims’ participation in trial proceedings notified on 1 September 2015 (the “Fourth Victim Participation Decision”), adopting a new procedure for the resumption of action by family members or closely-connected individuals of deceased victims and ordering *inter alia* the Registry to transmit any applications to resume the action of a deceased victim through its periodic reports if possible;²


NOTING articles 68(1) and (3) of the Rome Statute, rule 16 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulations 23*bis* and 86 of the Regulations of the Court (the “Regulations”);

CONSIDERING that, pursuant to regulation 23*bis* (1) of the Regulations, annex B of the present filing is submitted with the status “Confidential *ex parte*, only available to the Registry and the Legal Representatives of Victims” because it contains sensitive information that relates to the safety and physical well-being of victims or intermediaries;
