Judge Cuno Tarfusser, Single Judge exercising the functions of the Chamber in the present case, noting article 57(3)(a) and (c) of the Statute, issues this decision on the Prosecutor's "Demande de remise d'objets en possession desquels le Greffe est entré lors de l'arrestation de M. Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi" (ICC-01/12-01/15-73-Conf, "Prosecutor's Request").

- 1. In the warrant of arrest for Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi issued on 18 September 2015 (ICC-01/12-01/15-1-Red), the Single Judge ordered, *inter alia*, that with a view to preserving any potential evidence, at the moment of his arrest, Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi should be searched and any potentially relevant material in his possession seized.
- 2. On 9 December 2015, the Single Judge granted the Prosecutor's Request to inspect the personal belongings handed over to the Registry following the arrest of Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi (ICC-01/12-01/15-57). The Prosecutor (i) reports that the authorised inspection took place on 20 January 2016 in the presence of a representative of the Registry and of Counsel for Mr Al Mahdi and (ii) requests to be handed over three specific items among those seized and inspected, submitting that they would be of interest for the pursuit of the investigations and that they would need to be properly analysed and registered. The Prosecutor does not object to the remaining items being returned to Mr Al Mahdi.
- 3. The Single Judge considers that the Prosecutor's Request is grounded in the evidentiary reasons underlying the order to seize material in the possession of Mr Al Mahdi at the time of his arrest. By the same token, the requested items must only be retained by the Prosecutor to the extent that retention is strictly necessary to preserve those evidentiary needs and should be promptly returned to Mr Al Mahdi once those needs are fully satisfied.

FOR THESE REASONS, THE SINGLE JUDGE

GRANTS the Prosecutor's Request;

ORDERS the Registry to hand over to the Prosecutor the items listed in

paragraph 4 of the Prosecutor's Request and to promptly return to Ahmad Al

Faqi Al Mahdi all the other personal belongings inspected by the Prosecutor;

ORDERS the Prosecutor to promptly return to Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi the

items listed in paragraph 4 of the Prosecutor's Request once the evidentiary

needs underlying the Request will have been satisfied;

ORDERS the Prosecutor to file a public redacted version of the Request as

soon as practicable.
