Introduction

1. The Registry submits this report and its related annexes pursuant to Trial Chamber III's order (the "Trial Chamber") to:

"submit a report containing information about Mr Bemba's solvency and his conduct while in detention, including any information that may have come to the Registry's attention as to whether Mr Bemba has in any way compensated victims of the crimes committed".¹

Classification

2. In accordance with regulation 23bis (1) of the Regulations of the Court, the present report, Annex II and Annex III are classified as confidential pursuant to the Trial Chamber's order and as they contain information about the personal situation of Mr Bemba. Annex I is classified as confidential *ex parte*, Registry only, in view of the sensitive nature of its contents. Annex II is submitted as the confidential version of Annex I which is accessible to the parties and participants.

Mr Bemba's conduct while in detention


