THE PRESIDENCY of the International Criminal Court notes the “Decision on Defence request seeking leave to appeal the ‘Decision on request for compensation for unlawful detention’”¹ dated 13 May 2016 (“Appeal”) in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo, Aimé Kilolo Musamba, Jean-Jacques Mangenda Kabongo, Fidèle Babala Wandu and Narcisse Arido* (“*Bemba et al.*”).

The Presidency recalls that, on 20 March 2015, it granted the request of Judge Christine Van den Wyngaert for excusal from all future appeals in *Bemba et al.*²

The Presidency notes article 39(1) and (2)(b)(i) of the Rome Statute, rule 38 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence and regulations 12 and 15(1) of the Regulations of the Court.

The Presidency recalls that, on 20 March 2015, in accordance with the Presidency’s policy of effecting the replacement of a judge by lot from a roster of eligible judges, Judge Van den Wyngaert was replaced in the Appeals Chamber by Judge Péter Kovács for the purpose of six interlocutory appeals in the *Bemba et al.* case.³ The Presidency further recalls its policy that a judge already designated by lot may be subsequently designated to sit on other appeals under article 82 of the Rome Statute that arise in the same case.

The Presidency hereby decides, in the current circumstances, to temporarily attach Judge Kovács, currently assigned to the Pre-Trial Division, to the Appeals Chamber.

The Presidency hereby decides that the Appeals Chamber shall be composed as follows for the Appeal:


