

## I. Introduction

1. The Registry files this report following the decision of Pre-Trial Chamber II, dated 17 May 2016, in which the competent authorities of the Republic of Uganda were requested to submit, by 24 June 2016, their observations with respect to their failure to arrest and surrender Omar Al-Bashir while present on the territory of the Republic of Uganda ("Decision")<sup>1</sup>.

## II. Classification

2. The present report is filed public in line with the classification of the Decision. Pursuant to regulation 23*bis*(2) of the Regulations of the Court ("Regulations"), Annex 1 and 2 are filed as confidential, as they refer to the names of staff members of the Court and of the Ministry of Justice of the requested State.

## III. Applicable law

3. This report is submitted in accordance with rule 176 of the Rules of Procedures and Evidence ("Rules").

## IV. Submissions
