Background

1. On 21 March 2016, Trial Chamber III delivered its judgment under article 74 of

the Statute.1 Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo was found guilty under article 28 of the

Statute, of rape as a crime against humanity and war crime, murder as a crime

against humanity and war crime and pillage as a war crime.²

2. On 21 June 2016, Trial Chamber III issued its decision on the sentence pursuant

to article 76³ and sentenced Mr Bemba to a total of 18 years of imprisonment.⁴

Appeal pursuant to Articles 81(2)(a) and 83(2) and (3) of the Statute

3. The Prosecution is appealing the Sentencing Decision, pursuant to articles

81(2)(a) and 83(2) and (3) of the Statute.

4. For reasons that will be provided in its document in support of the appeal, the

Prosecution will request the Appeals Chamber to reverse the joint sentence of 18

years of imprisonment⁵ and to revise it by increasing the term of imprisonment. This

revision should reflect the totality of Mr Bemba's culpability, as found by the Trial

Chamber.
