I. Introduction

1. On 12 March 2012, the Single Judge of Pre-Trial Chamber II ordered the Victims Participation and Reparations Section (“VPRS”) to submit every four months, following the submission of a Comprehensive Report on the *status quo* of all applications received in the Situation in Uganda,¹ a periodic report on applications received and the progress made by the VPRS on their assessment under rule 85 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence.²

II. Classification

2. Consistent with previous practice and pursuant to regulation 23*bis*(1) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”), the present report is submitted as a confidential annex, *EX PARTE*, available only to the Registry, to the public filing in order to enable the inclusion in such reports of identifying information or information relating to the protection of victims whenever necessary.

III. Applicable Law


