#### I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby files in the record of the case of the *Prosecutor v. Dominic Ongwen* ("Ongwen case") confidential lesser redacted versions of 38 applications for participation of dual status individuals.

## II. Procedural history

- 2. On 23 January 2017, Trial Chamber IX ("Chamber") ordered the Registry to file in the record of the *Ongwen* case lesser redacted versions of 22 applications¹ for participation in the proceedings of dual status individuals represented by the Common Legal Representative of Victims (Ms Paolina Massidda) and of 16 applications² of dual status individuals represented by the Legal Representative of Victims (Mr Joseph Akwenyu Manoba and Mr Francisco Cox) ("Order of 23 January 2017").³
- 3. On 23 and 31 January 2017, the Common Legal Representative of Victims and the Legal Representative of Victims, respectively, transmitted to the Registry their proposed redactions to be applied in the 38 applications, in light of the Chamber's instructions.<sup>4</sup>
