I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby transmits to the Defence, the Legal Representative of Victims (“LRV”), the Office of Public Counsel for Victims (“OPCV”), the Prosecutor and the Trust Fund for Victims (“TFV”) as an annex to this filing, the application form of an expert who has been added to the general list of experts maintained by the Registry in accordance with regulation 44(1) of the Regulations of the Court (“RoC”) as well as his *Curriculum Vitae* (“Annex”).

II. Procedural history

2. On 14 and 16 February 2017, the Registry informed Trial Chamber III (“Chamber”) that an expert with relevant expertise on reparations was received and added to the general list of experts maintained by the Registry in accordance with regulation 44(1) of the RoC (“Expert”).¹
3. On 21 February 2017, the Chamber ordered the Registry to provide the application form and the *Curriculum Vitae* of the Expert to the Defence, the LRV and the OPCV (“21 February 2017 Order”).²
4. On 22 February 2017, the Registry transmitted by email to the Defence, the LRV and the OPCV, the application form and the *Curriculum Vitae* of the Expert,³ after which the Chamber additionally instructed the Registry to formally file them in the record of the case, on a confidential basis, and to also notify the Prosecution and the TFV (“22 February 2017 Order”).⁴
