I. Introduction

1. In accordance with rule 13(1) of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, the Registry hereby transmits to Trial Chamber VIII ("Chamber") a request ("Request") from the experts appointed on 19 January 2017 by the Chamber in its "Decision Appointing Reparations Experts and Partly Amending Reparations Calendar" ("Decision"), in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi* ("Al Mahdi case").

II. Procedural History

- 2. In the Decision, the Chamber appointed four experts ("Appointed Experts") on areas it had previously identified as relevant for the reparations proceedings in the *Al Mahdi* case², and ordered them to submit their reports to the Chamber and the parties by 24 March 2017.³
- 3. On 8 March 2017, the Registry received an email from the Appointed Experts requesting an extension of the deadline for the submission of their reports to 28 April 2017 and setting out the reasons justifying the Request.⁴

III. Classification

4. Pursuant to regulation 23*bis*(2) of the Regulations of the Court and in line with the confidential classification of the Decision, the annex to the present submission is classified as confidential;⁵ a public redacted version is also being made available.
