### Introduction

1. The Office of the Prosecutor ("Prosecution") provides notice of the disclosure of material falling within rule 77 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence ("the Rules").

### Disclosure of evidence

- 2. On 18 January 2016, the Prosecution disclosed a total of 8 items under the provision of rule 77 of the Rules.
- 3. These materials included (1) an investigation note and the witness preparation session log and disclosure note for Witness P-07901 and (2) six verbatim transcriptions of [REDACTED].2
