## I. Introduction

1. Pursuant to the “Order on Publicity of Case Record” (“Order”)<sup>1</sup> of Trial Chamber VIII (“Chamber”), the Registry hereby files the public redacted versions of applications for reparations previously transmitted in the case of *The Prosecutor v. Ahmad Al Faqi Al Mahdi* (“Al Mahdi case”).

## II. Procedural History

2. On 16 and 22 December 2016 respectively, the Registry transmitted to the Chamber<sup>2</sup> and to the Defence<sup>3</sup> 135 applications for reparations in the *Al Mahdi* case (“135 Applications”), in accordance with the Chamber’s “Reparations Phase Calendar”.<sup>4</sup>
3. On 24 March 2017, the Registry transmitted to the Chamber a further four applications for reparations (“Four Applications”)<sup>5</sup> and, on the same date, the Legal Representatives of Victims (“LRV”) transmitted to the Chamber the original versions of additional documents related to the 135 Applications (“Additional documents”).<sup>6</sup>

4. On 24 April 2017, the Registry transmitted to the Defence the Four Applications and the Additional Documents in redacted versions.<sup>7</sup>
5. On 11 July 2017, the Chamber ordered the Victims Participation and Reparations Section (“VPRS”), in consultation with the LRV, to file public redacted versions of all applications for reparations previously transmitted in the *Al Mahdi* case (“139 Applications”), no later than 6 October 2017.<sup>8</sup>

### III. Applicable Law

6. The Registry submits the public redacted versions of the 139 Applications in accordance with articles 68(1) and 75 of the Rome Statute, rules 16, 85 and 94 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulation 88 of the Regulations of the Court, regulation 110 of the Regulations of the Registry, and in accordance with the Order.

### IV. Submission


7. The VPRS prepared public redacted versions of the 139 Applications in consultation with the LRV and the Victims and Witnesses Unit. Redactions have been applied to potentially identifying and sensitive information in order to protect, *inter alia*, the safety of victims, members of their family and third parties.
