1. In accordance with the Appeals Chamber's order of 12 December 2017,¹ the Prosecution hereby files a list of all the relevant decisions, orders and transcripts of the Court, and other authorities, to which it may refer during the forthcoming appeal hearing.² Materials which are not published by this Court may be accessed either through electronic hyperlinks,³ or are provided in further annexes.⁴
2. The Prosecution further notes its intention, in order to facilitate the conduct of the hearing, to file a list of some of these *same* authorities in an alternative form (*i.e.*, grouping specific authorities relevant to a common proposition together). This will provide a convenient *aide-memoire* for the Parties and participants during the hearing, and avoid the need for lengthy references to authority which otherwise might be necessary for certain submissions. The Prosecution will file this further list by 16:00 on Monday 8 January.
3. Finally, the Prosecution notes that it files this list of authorities without prejudice to its reference during the hearing to any further materials which may become relevant in the course of argument by the other Parties or participants.
