I. Introduction

1. The Registry hereby informs the Pre-Trial Chamber that Mr Essa Mbye Faal (“Mr Faal”), a lawyer on the List of Counsel of the International Criminal Court has been appointed as Associate Counsel for Mr Saif Al-Islam Gaddafi on 21 April 2018.

III. Applicable Law



This submission is made on the basis of articles 43 and 67(1)(d) of the Rome Statute, rules 20 to 22 of the Rules of Procedure and Evidence, regulation 67 of the RoC, regulation 123(1) of the Regulations of the Registry, articles 5 and 7(4) of the Code of Professional Conduct for counsel (“Code”).

IV. Submissions

4. On 25 April 2018 the Registry formalised the appointment of Associate Counsel.¹
