1. The Prosecution submitted its fifth update of its List of Evidence¹ (LOE) on 12 December 2017, following the Trial Chamber's approval² of the request to add the materials related to the mental health experts to the LOE.
2. In that update, the Prosecution inadvertently omitted some of the approved items from the LOE. The items³ are the open source materials which were referenced in the report of Prosecution Expert UGA-OTP-P-0445,⁴ and also used during her testimony.⁵ The same materials were subsequently subject of a request for formal submission of evidence⁶ and approved by the Trial Chamber.⁷
3. As two additional updates to the LOE have taken place since the submission of the fifth update, the Prosecution will respectfully provide the items as an update to the last version⁸ in order to maintain the consecutive arrangement of the numbering on the list.
4. Annex A is filed as "Confidential" pursuant to regulation 23*bis* of the Regulations of the Court, because it contains information that is classified as confidential in the case record.
