On 11 May 2018, the Pre-Trial Chamber convened a status conference, to be held in closed session on 20 June 2018.<sup>1</sup> To facilitate the conduct of this status conference, the Prosecution hereby files a list of all relevant documents, emanating from sources outside the Court, to which it may refer in its submissions.<sup>2</sup>
2. The further annexes to this filing contain copies of those documents, for the Pre-Trial Chamber's ease of reference following the hearing.<sup>3</sup> The Prosecution does *not* anticipate that the Pre-Trial Chamber will need to be familiar with the content of these documents during the hearing itself. Rather, these materials are only provided in full in the interests of candour and completeness, since they contain policy statements by third parties.
3. These materials are filed confidentially, and *ex parte*, to maintain the 'closed' nature of the status conference. However, since the materials themselves are public documents, obtained by the Prosecution as 'open sources', this filing and its annexes may be reclassified as necessary, to conform with the classification of the transcript of the status conference itself.
