I. Introduction


1. The Registry hereby submits in annex to this submission a report from the Chief Custody Officer (“CCO”) on the behaviour of Mr Jean-Pierre Bemba Gombo (“Mr Bemba”) while he was in the ICC Detention Centre (“DC”), as ordered by Trial Chamber VII.¹
